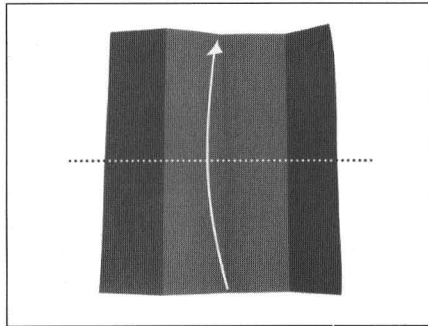
1. Fold a square in half from side to side.



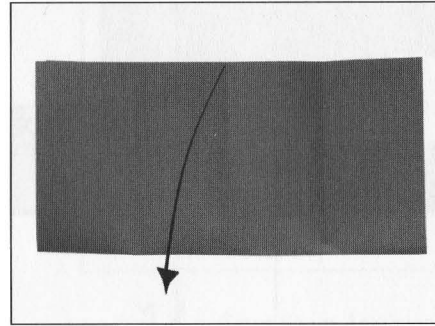

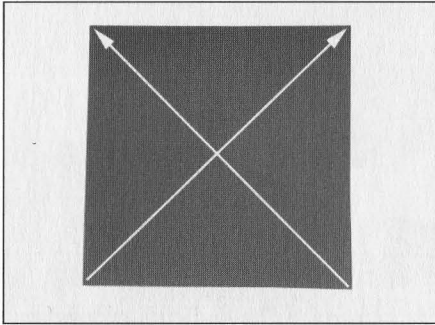
If you start with large pieces and slowly make them 1 millimeter smaller every 8, you can create a rather imposing whip.



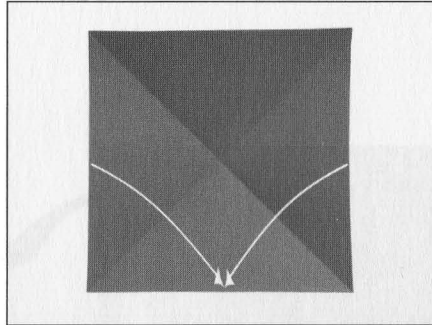

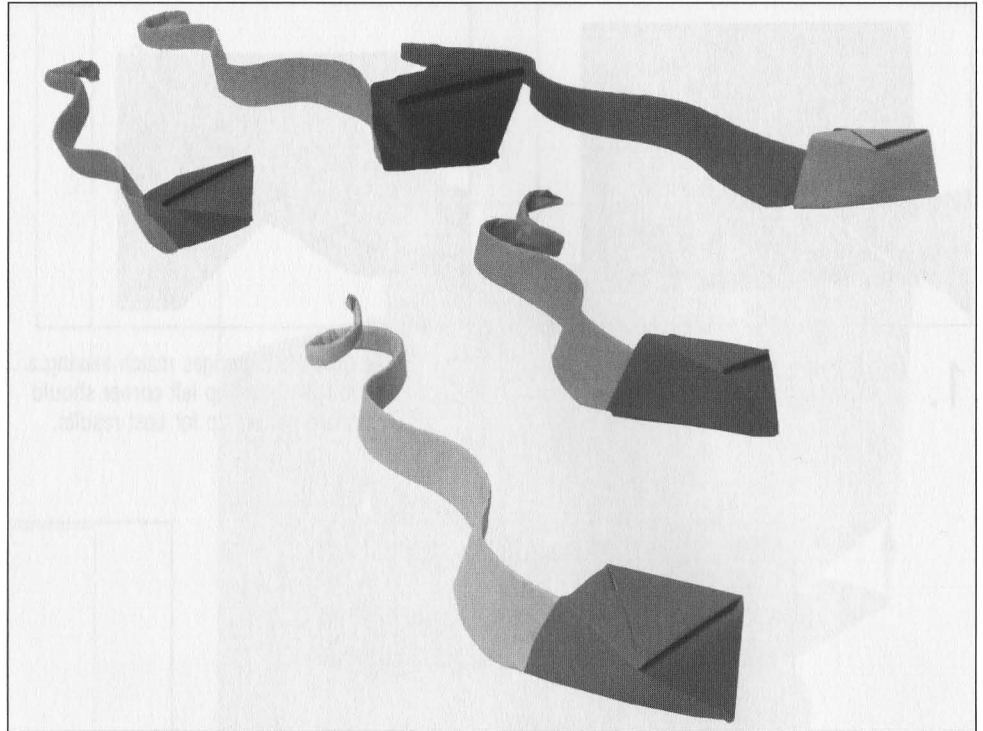


The Ovum edges can be "squared" into a cube and used as a die. Each side can note a different love-making technique to be used that evening.

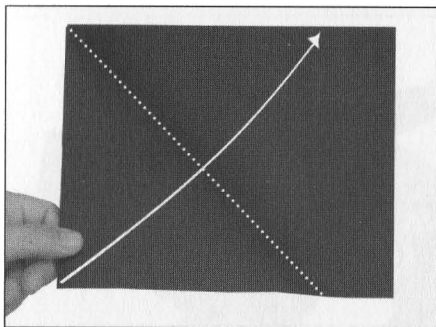




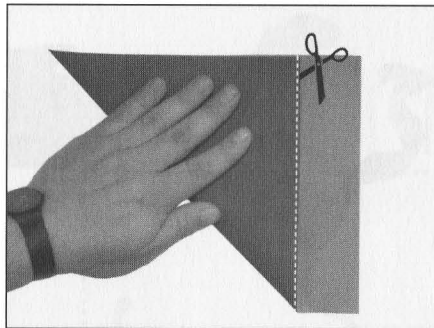

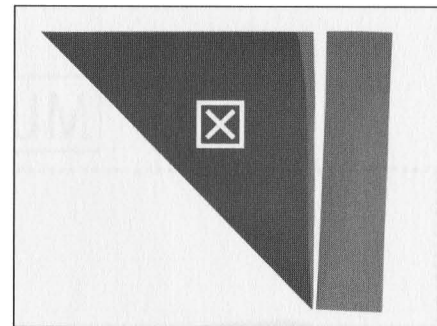
This figure should be folded from a long strip of paper with a 1:4 ratio, even a dollar bill will work. If you already have a strip, go to step 4. The first 3 steps illustrate how to make a square from any rectangular paper.



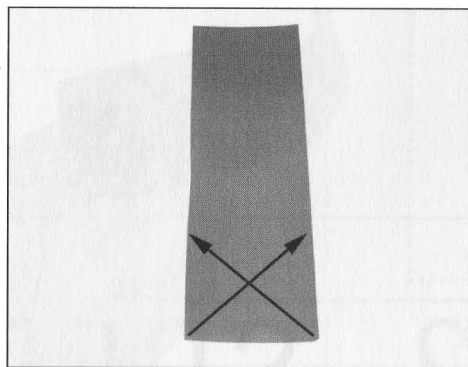
1. Using a rectangle of simple copy paper, fold one corner to the other side.



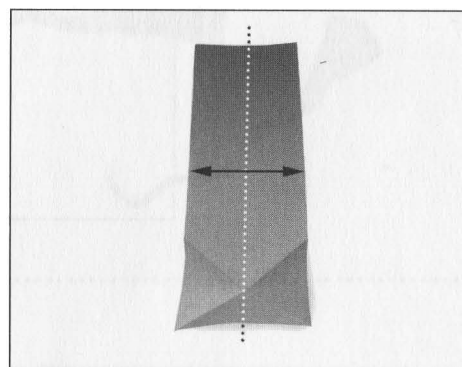
2. Note how the top edges match leaving a strip to the right. Top left corner should be a sharp perfect tip for best results.



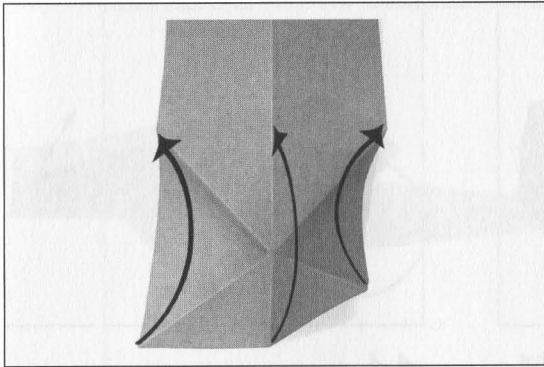
3. Cut off exposed edge. The figure with an "X" is a square and can be used for other figures. Use the strip to make a Sperm.



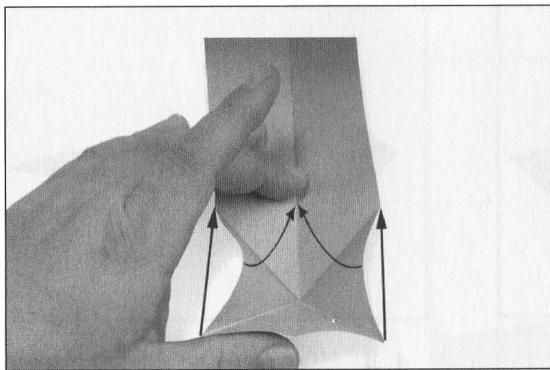
4. Similar to step 1, fold the right and left tips over to the sides to create a valley-folded "X."



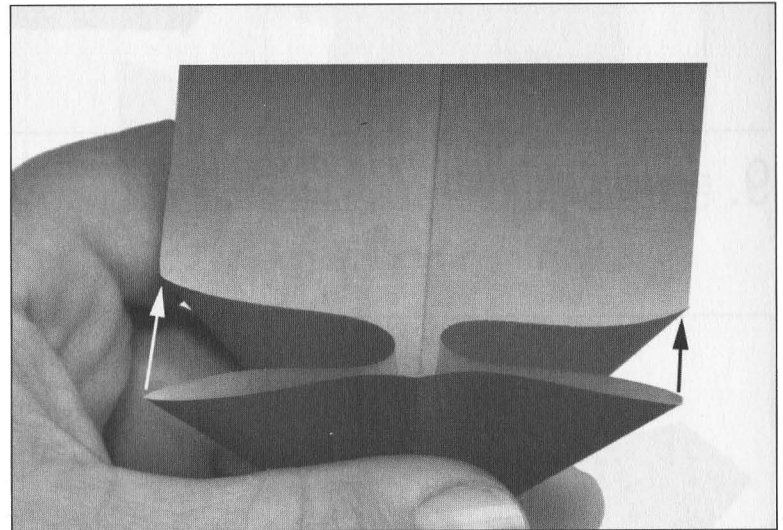
5. Create a center crease down the length of the figure by folding in half and back again.



6. Bring tips up as indicated by arrows. The right and left sides between them should meet.

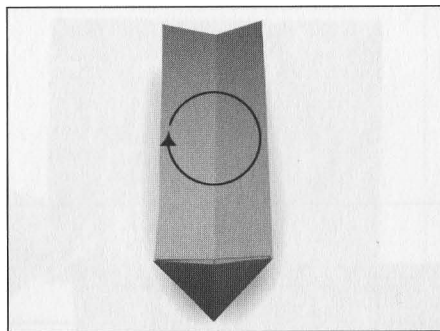

NOTE: A basic Penis can be folded from ANY rectangular paper or a square that has been folded or cut in half.



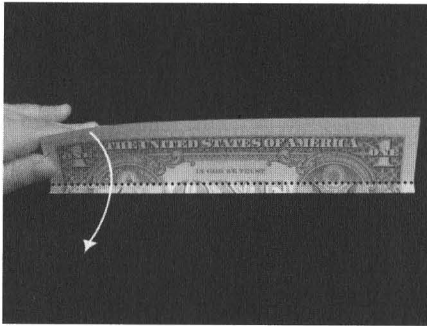
