Some jamaican group with a black, white and hispanic dude. They ain't sue me they just tried to get a settlement out of court. I am the real COMMON SENSE aka Rasheed

#### DO YOU WANT TO SAY ANYTHING TO THE SHORTIES?

You know as business men we are trying to get together, it ain't all about money, but we are trying to live comfortable and help our community. I would tell them to be business minded regardless of their rap, be smart and invest in real estate or open up a business of you own like my man Dug at Underground Wheels.

# ONE LAST THING, WOULD YOU LIKE TO CLEAR UP ANYTHING THING FOR OUR WEST COAST READERS ON THIS MACK 10 ISSUE?

# **ON ABSTRACTION**

AS AN ARTIST, EXPLORING TO ANOTHER LEVEL OF GRAFFITI IS A CHALLENGE. (abstraction) IS THE NUMBER ONE FORM OF EXPRESSION.

IT TAKES MORE THOUGHT AND CREATIVITY
THAN CREATING A TRADITIONAL PIECE (with letters), LETTERS OFFER A BASE, A READY MADE
STRUCTURE, AND THEN COMES A NEW

CREATION. NOT DOWNING ARTISTS
WHO USE LETTERS IN PIECES (I have), I'M
ONLY URGING YOU TO ELEVATE.

CHICAGO DOESN'T HAVE A CERTAIN STYLE, (we have many) MAYBE WE CAN BECOME THE CITY THAT ONLY ROCKS ABSTRACTS.

# THE FUTURE OF THE SPRAY CAN

JIM AND I WERE DISCUSSING THE FUTURE OF SPRAY CAN ART, AND IT SEEMS TO HIGH CLASS SOCIALITES, THAT THE SUBCULTURE WILL REMAIN A LESSER ART FORM. ONLY A FEW NEW YORK MASTERS HAVE EXCELLED THROUGH GRAFFITI, AND MANY OF THEM MOVED TO EUROPE.
